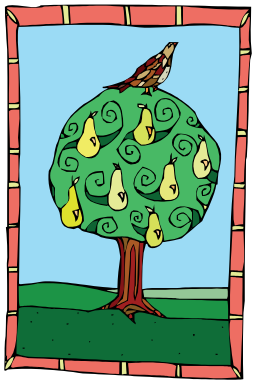

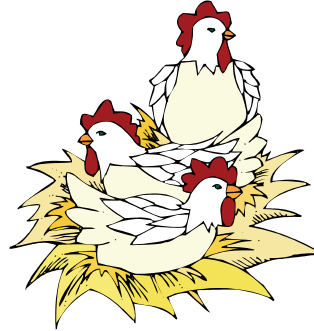

Things to Know

Attire

- Show attire or Red or green polo shirt with boots and breeches required for all classes.
- Helmets must be worn while mounted. **The USEF requires all riders to wear USEF approved head gear.**

Classes

- Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes if necessary.
- Six ribbons awarded in each class. Presents for 1st place and special prizes for 2nd (red) and 6th (green) place. Championship and reserve awarded in all divisions. You must be entered in the entire division to be eligible for championship and reserve.
- Riders in the Cross rail division can only cross enter into the Beginner division.
- Martingales allowed in Cross rail flat and Cross rail U/S only.
- Riders in Beginner cannot show over 2'3".
- Juniors will show separate heights but will be pinned together.
- One jumper class will be optimum time and the other table 2- 2b.
- Oxers will not be put in until 2'6".

Stalls

- Because of the cost of manure removal, first bedding is **not** included. Shavings must be purchased from horse show management at \$7 per bag.
- Stalls will be available after Noon on Saturday.
- All stalls cancelled after 9 a.m. on Thursday July 5th, 2012 will be charged to trainers.

Schooling

- Saturday Noon to Dusk., Sunday Dawn until 7:30.
- A warm-up area is available during the show. In addition, a warm-up card will remain open throughout the hunter divisions. Fence heights to change with respective divisions.

Miscellaneous

- **No smoking** in or near any building!
- All dogs must be on a leash.
- Current, 2012, negative coggins required with all entries.

Open to Juniors and Adult Amateurs. Includes and equitation over fences round and a flat phase. To be competed at 2', 2'6 or 3'-Horses will jump different heights, but they will all compete in the flat phase together. Horses may be shared, but must jump different heights. There will be two flat sections to accommodate ring space and shared horses. Each rider will receive a score for their jumping round and their flat phase. The highest total score wins!

Entry fee:\$45

Prize money will be divvied out as follows:

- 1st:\$165
- 2nd:\$125
- 3rd: \$85
- 4th: \$55
- 5th: \$40
- 6th: \$30
